

The AFF Course offers a fast-track route into the World of Skydiving!!
After just one day of ground-training you're ready to jump with your own parachute from up to 15,000ft and enjoy over ONE MINUTE of freefall with two expert instructors!!

What does the course consist of?

The full course consists of theory training on the ground and seven skydives (7 Levels). On Levels 1 to 3 you are accompanied by two instructors and on successful completion of these skydives you will move on to Levels 4 to 7 with just one instructor.

The principal objective of Level 1 is to gain a stable position during freefall, open your own parachute and get used to flying your new equipment!

During subsequent levels you will learn more skills such as 90 and 360 degree turns, back loops and tracking.

Those of you wishing to gain a British Parachute Association license to jump in the UK, will need to complete a further jumps; Level 8 which is a solo exit from a lower altitude of 5,000ft and 10 consolidation jumps from 15,000ft practicing the skills you have learnt, whilst supervised in the aircraft by an instructor.

Remember, we offer 15,000ft on Levels 1-7, giving you 15 secs more in freefall per jump than other centers, helping to reduce the possibility of repeat levels.

How long does it take?

The Groundschool starts at 9am usually on Tuesdays and Fridays and will take the best part of the day and all being well you should do your Level 1 skydive at the end of your training or the next morning.

For students from abroad wanting to complete the full course we recommend 7 – 10 days especially if you are wanting to also complete your consolidation jumps. Some students progress faster than others and it also allows time in the event of bad weather (although it's normally very good here in Sevilla!!) and any repeat levels you may need.

For students living in Spain who cannot stay for a full week, please try and make two or three consecutive weekends available. The best way to progress is to complete the jumps as close together as possible. If you leave large spaces of time between levels you may find you have to undergo retraining (at an additional cost) and repeat the previous level. If you are able to perhaps attend the Groundschool on a Friday this will give you both Saturday and Sunday to complete a large portion of the course

How to book...

The centre is open every day of the year however you need to book in advance to schedule your initial training date. In order to make a reservation you need to provide us with some personal details including your:

- Age, weight and height (please see restrictions for details)
- Mobile phone number (which functions in Spain)
- plus a non-refundable deposit of £100 per person payable either by credit or debit card (3% charge). Just call our UK Office on +44(0)113 250 5600 and they will take all your details.

Restrictions

Unfortunately there are some age, weight and health restrictions that apply to solo students including:

- Maximum weight limit of 95kg (this is also dependant on your height and we reserve the right to refuse students who exceed the recommended Body Mass Index, however exceptions may be made for those who are heavy due to large muscle up to 100kg). Giving incorrect personal information when booking may result in you forfeiting all the costs for the course.
- Maximum age limit of 50 and the minimum age is 16 with a parent present to sign consent.
- If you are aged 40 or over and/or have any medical problems you must obtain a medical form from Skydive Spain to be signed by your doctor. Please bring both sides of the form with you on the day.

If you have any queries about our restrictions please contact us before you make a booking.

Insurance

All solo skydivers are required to show written proof of 3rd party liability insurance for skydiving (please specify skydiving not parachuting!) whilst in Spain.

Some travel insurance companies may provide this but please ask them specifically for confirmation.

We also of course highly recommend personal accident insurance. (Please note that UK travel insurance companies may only cover you if you are a UK resident.)

Sportscover Direct provide a variety of policies including Ventureguard which should cover for travel as well or look at STA Travel, M&S and Adrenalin travel.

The Andalucian Aerosports Federation offer membership for 1 month (75€), for 3 months (85€) and until the 31st December 2010 (120€). www.feada.org If you require this Spanish insurance, please tell us in advance.

Accommodation

Our primary and most popular accommodation options are self-catering apartments in the nearby town of Bormujos – the Apartours, the Lux Sevilla and the Domo Center, however for individuals the Campus Patrimonial offers cheaper rooms, and the Gadafi, although room-only, is closer to the dropzone. There is also an onsite bunkhouse offering shared dorm rooms costing 12€ per bed per night. We can make your accommodation booking for you.
