What's on offer...

1-on-1 coaching - There is usually a very high demand for 1-on-1 coaching. To avoid disappointment, please get in touch early and book your jumps. We will work on a first come first served basis and if you wait until you get to the boogie we unfortunately cannot guarantee that we will get to you. But we will do our best!

Load organising – It is our goal to provide load organising for all levels, the following is a taste of what will be on offer:



Low experience

Small head-up skydives working on the basics of flying within a group, heading and level control and clean safe break-offs.

Small tracking skydives working modern tracking techniques and theory.

Hybrid dives, tube jumps etc

Intermediate and experienced

Larger slot specific head-up/head-down skydives

Small head-down skydives working on the basics of VFS, flying in a base, approaching a formation, grip taking and clean safe break-offs. Building to larger formations.

Larger tracking dives, working on modern tracking techniques and theory, approaching and flying in a formation.

Advanced

Sequential head –up/head-down formation skydives.

Bigway head-down formations.

Formation tracking dives with heading and angle changes.

Sky ball jumps – with coach/LO or with consent.

Progression

We will be looking to progress people wherever possible. The nature of freeflying is such that we need to restrict the size of groups for safety reasons, however we will help those who have proved themselves to take part in larger and more challenging skydives.

Aircraft

As usual we will have a fleet of super fast G92 turbine Dorniers that will be flying to 15000ft in around 12 minutes. In the past this has allowed participants to do up 10 skydives per day!

Day Video

Every night Andy Lovemore will put together a day video to be shown in the bar while people sip on a cold beer or two (or 3 or 4....). An opportunity to check out what everyone has been up to throughout the day in every discipline.
