

## External Skydiving Schools

### Welcome

We are very pleased that you are considering our DZ to run your School.

We offer very fast turbine aircraft with a very large student-friendly door. The Dornier G92 twin turbine flies to 15,000 feet on every flight in less than 15 minutes, providing a full minute and more in freefall for the students to achieve all the in-air skills to easily pass each jump.

We are open 7 days a week, however it is always advisable that you contact us before arranging your trip as we can recommend the best dates in accordance with the activity we already have booked in.

Our centre is situated in the outskirts Bollullos de la Mitación only 30 minutes drive from beautiful and historic Seville city centre. We experience some of the best weather in Europe all year round due to our southern location, our busiest time period is October to April during this period we almost always have 2x Dornier G92 aircraft flying.

If you are interested in keeping your equipment at our drop zone when you are not here we will be happy to assist you. We all know how difficult, expensive and risky it is to bring your parachutes abroad using low cost airlines and we have lockers available.

Skydive Spain has a **BPA Advanced Instructor and USPA Safety & Training Advisor**. This enables the DZ to assist in any BPA or USPA licensing signatures you might require.

We have top quality student rigs available for rent. UPT VectorSE containers with skyhooks, Vigil AADs and Navigator main canopies ranging from 300 sq ft down to 220 sq ft. Below this, our further hire rigs range from 200 sq ft down to 149 sq ft.

If you will require our student equipment and/or AFF instructors please let us know in advance. The Skydive Spain instructor given to you will be decided by our Chief Instructor and based on availability. If you operate with radio talk-down please bring your own radios, we are always happy to assist if necessary.

Skydive Spain will not accept external schools with students that are Spanish nationals and/or reside in Spain.

For any external schools who make reoccurring visits, a separate Approved Agreement may be drawn up and must be signed annually.

We apply our standard rates to all the group of external schools (AFF students, instructors, licensed jumpers etc). Please check them in our website, where they are updated accordingly.

We are receiving an increasing number of requests for printing and scanning paperwork for customers. We are happy to do this for everyone, however we need to add a charge of 0,15€ per photocopy or printed page to cover the costs incurred by our rented machine.

Upon your arrival we request that the group leader deposits a lump sum on his/her account for the costs of the school to be debited from. When the account starts to get low, we will inform you to deposit more money. At any time, you may request the DZ office to print out your accounts financial information to assess your expenditure. If you require an invoice, please inform us on your arrival, we cannot provide invoices retrospectively.

## Insurance

All your group; instructor(s) and students must have the mandatory Third Party Liability insurance for skydiving in Spain. Bring the full policy wording to be checked. Depending on the nationality and

residency of your group members, we may be able to provide insurance via the Andalucian Federation, please request further information from our reservations office.

## Travel and Accommodation

The DZ is not reachable by public transport therefore we highly recommend a rental car. The closest airport is Seville, however Faro (in Portugal) is only a 2 hours drive and the car hire options can be cheaper, or there is Malaga, which is a 2.5 hour drive. ## Booking Process

We require some specific information to make sure your check-in day will be as smooth as possible. We provide a blank excel sheet for you to complete.

### General

- Arrival date and time to DZ
- Last day of activity at the DZ  
if people within group are arriving at different times, please inform us

### Instructors

- Full name
- Scan copy of valid instructor rating
- Total No. of jumps
- No. of AFF instructional jumps
- Date of last AFF instructional jump  
If the instructor has less than 50 AFF jumps will only be allowed to do secondary instructor jumps;  
Always when in case of low experience Instructors (less than 200 AFF jumps), the possibility of doing primary Instructor jumps will be checked with CI;
- Copy of insurance to be used or request for Spanish insurance
- Skydive Spain instructors required: Yes or No  
if yes, for how many jumps?

## Students

- Full name, age, weight and height
- Own Student gear: Yes or No  
if no, what size Skydive Spain canopy will they need?
- Copy of insurance to be used or request for Spanish insurance

Our standard Course Restrictions apply, even to external schools.

- Minimum age of 16 years. Those under 18 must have parental consent by a notarized signature on our three Skydive Spain forms.
- Any medical problems must be acknowledged in our Fitness form signed and stamped by a doctor, please request it from [info@skydivespain.com](mailto:info@skydivespain.com).
- Maximum age limit of 49. From 50 to 55 years an in-person assessment by main Instructor of External School will be required, who will decide whether the student is able to or not to take the course. On arrival to the DZ our Safety Officer will talk to you about your students. People who are 56 years old and older will not be allowed to do the AFF course.
- Maximum weight limit of 95 kg (15 stone/209 lbs) – this is also dependent on height and we reserve the right to refuse students who exceed the recommended Body Mass Index. However, exceptions may be made for those who are heavy due to large muscle up to 100kg.

**We remind you, all students are your responsibility (External School Main Instructor and Group Organiser) during your visit and while using Skydive Spain facilities.**

## Safety and Relevant DZ Rules

As Skydive Spain grows bigger we are attracting more and more external schools. It is becoming more complicated for us, as a drop zone, to assist everyone to have a safe working environment that we are all comfortable to work within. This environment includes our manifest, aircraft, airspace and landing area.

We have put some very basic guidelines together, which are easy for every school to follow. We believe this keeps our safety level to a high and also fun standard that we owe to our students and fellow instructors.

Skydive Spain staff will check any student equipment you bring, and all rigs used for student jumping must be fitted with an RSL. Skydive Spain is an AAD mandatory DZ for all equipment. All your instructors must bring their valid instructor ratings each visit for inspection by our Chief Instructor.

All students (let's call a student anyone completing the 7 AFF levels and has less than 10 solo jumps after level 7) must have revision training from their instructor every morning before jumping starts, which includes emergencies and canopy control as a bare minimum. We think it shows us as better instructors if we record the revision training in the student's log book as well.

The first 10 solo jumps after successful completion of AFF L7 (consolidation jumps) are to be supervised in the aircraft by a minimum of an FS / USPA coach. If your student wants to manifest please be ready to dispatch them yourself. Skydive Spain regularly has instructors on the aircraft, so we are more than happy to supervise them for you, if asked in advance. In return we hope you would also be happy to supervise our students when your instructors are jumping.

Please remain on the drop zone whilst your students are jumping, if you need to leave for any reason just ask us to keep an eye on your students for you whilst you are away. Like already mentioned, we are happy to dispatch your students for you, as long as they have been refreshed and this daily instruction is recorded in their log book.

We have lots of training aids for you to use here at Skydive Spain which include; walk-around malfunction harnesses, malfunction pictures, throw away practice belts, white boards, aerial photographs, creepers, freefall technique bench, suspended harnesses, mock up, classrooms with PCs, the secluded de-briefing area with 3 screens as well as the two large screens in the hangar.

All of the training aids are free and available for you to use for your students. All we ask is that you leave them back where they belong. Also please leave the areas/classrooms how you found them before you used it. This helps the centre maintain a clean working environment for all of us.

## Tandem Skydiving

Due to insurance reasons, external instructors are not permitted to make instructional tandem jumps. Tandem Instructor candidates on affiliated instructor courses must notify us in advance and provide the appropriate insurance to cover the skydives.

## and finally...

Upon check-in your group will be given a DZ orientation brief by a member of Skydive Spain staff, this is mandatory even though we know you will be briefing your own students as you see fit for their AFF course. It is vitally important that all the instructors follow our DZ rules for the safety of everyone.
